

JewishColumbus channels funds from the Annual Campaign and Foundation Funds into meaningful initiatives that strengthen our community. Our focus spans several key areas.




Enrich Jewish Life & Instill Jewish Pride

Our educational efforts include support for preschools, religious schools, and Kollel programs. We offer significant funding for day schools, ensuring every student receives support regardless of their payment status.




Protect Our Community
