Israel: History and Post Oct 7

Israel

- Roughly the size of New Jersey
- 9.4 Million (21% Arab)
- Jews have lived in the land of Israel CONTINUOUSLY for 4,000 years



Founding of Israel

- Theodor Herzl
- Leading to statehood
 - 1917 Balfour Declaration
 - League of Nations, British Mandate for Palestine, 1922
 - UN Partition Plan, 1947
- Democratic Jewish State 1948



Democracy

- Considered only functional democracy in the Middle East
- All citizens allowed to vote (21% not Jewish)
- 23 Islamic Countries, 1 Jewish Country



Key Players

- Iran and Axis of Resistance
 - Hezbollah
 - Hamas
 - Houthis
- Palestine Liberation Organization



Terrorism and Wars against Israel

- War of Independence, 1948
- Six Day Way, 1967
- El Al hijacking, 1968
- Yom Kippur War, 1973
- First Intifada, 1987-1990
- Second Intifada, 2000
- Gaza Operations, 2008-2009; 2012; 2014;
- Oct 7-present



Peace Efforts*

- UN Resolutions following Six Day War and Yom Kippur War
- Camp David Accords, 1978
- Oslo Accords
- Camp David Summit, 2000
- Disengagement from Gaza, 2005
- Trump Peace Plan, 2020



Peace Efforts

In every instance, Israel accepted the proposal, while the Palestinian Authority rejected it.



October 7, 2023

- Over 1,200 men, women and children slaughtered by Hamas
- Largest massacre of Jews since the Holocaust
- Victims include 46 Americans and citizens of more than 30 countries



Since October 7

- Over 40,000 rocket attacks Gaza, Lebanon, Iran
- Ground offensive in Gaza to destroy Hamas
- Ground offensive in Lebanon to destroy Hezbollah
- Israel-Hezbollah Ceasefire adopted Nov 27, 2024
- Civilian-to-Military deaths ratio among the lowest in wartime approaching 1:1



251 Hostages

- 63 Still held captive
- 117 Returned alive
 - 105 through the Nov 2023 ceasefire
 - 8 rescued in summer 2024
 - 4 released by Hamas
- 71 Killed
 - 34 bodies remain in Gaza



Rise of Jew Hatred

Rising Jew Hatred

- 300% increase in Antisemetic incidents since Oct 7th
- More antisemetic incidents 10/7/23 1/7/24 than all of 2022.
- 70% of Jewish students report facing at least one form of antisemitism



The Impact

- Discrimination and intimidation at K-12 and on college campuses
- Physical attacks
- Professional discrimination

IHRA definition

"Antisemitism is a certain perception of Jews, which may be expressed as hatred toward Jews. Rhetorical and physical manifestations of antisemitism are directed toward Jewish or non-Jewish individuals and/or their property, toward Jewish community institutions and religious facilities."
