Our School

- Founded in September 1958 with 11 students

- Moved to current campus in 1975 - High School founded in 1991
- Currently serves 231 students in kindergarten through grade 12 plus Gan Ephraim preschool partnership with 61 students ages 2 ½ -5
- Student-Teacher ratio is 8:1 (Upper School) and 11:1 (Lower School)

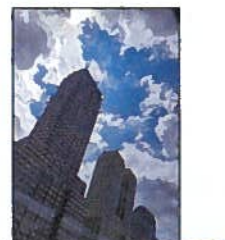
